Among others, this IRP requires assessing the needs and resources of Puerto Rico's power system for achieving the goal of providing a reliable, resilient, and environmentally amicable electrical service, at the least cost possible, and promoting the participation of all stakeholders. The IRP shall also consider PREPA's current financial situation, which is subject to the Title III of PROMESA federal act.

Therefore, we hereby extend an RFP invitation for your organization to participate in this tendering process. Financial exigencies require that the proposals and, subsequently, the IRP itself be delivered under an accelerated timeline. Consequently, only firms with the ability to devote significant (and concentrated) resource capacity to this IRP should submit proposals.
